## Recycling 130: Commercial & Institutional Recycling

### Course Overview

Recycling 135 will provide participants with an introduction of the basic steps needed to develop a cost-effective, sustainable institutional or business recycling program. A field trip will include an actual waste assessment. Attendants should be prepared for dinner on their own. Upon completion of this course, participants will receive a Penn State certificate verifying the .6 CEUs earned toward the Certified Recycling Professional program.

Recycling 130 will include a report by the attendees from all of the information and data they have experienced and tallied. They will also compose a written summation of observations and recycling recommendations. Upon completion of this course, participants will receive a Penn State certificate verifying the .4 CEUs earned toward the Certified Recycling Professional program.
