### Course Overview

**Recycling 352 - Recycling Facility Design:** This course will describe the elements of recycling facility design, the integration of Green Building source-separated and commingled-container processing, and basic operational practices. The class will include discussions on the benefits and challenges of source-separated and commingled-container processing.

**Recycling 360 - Commodities Marketing:** This is an advanced course for those currently using marketing materials or those who wish to learn more about marketing. Our instructors will cover various topics such as, but not limited to: understanding the market and how it works; quality and transportation as it relates to recycling markets; contracts; floor/ceiling prices; spot marketing; market indicators; and the demand side of the industry.

- Participants will leave with a better knowledge of green building practices and the benefits and challenges of source-separated and commingled processing methods.
- Participants will gain insight on the ins and outs of the marketing world and various issues that go along with the industry.
