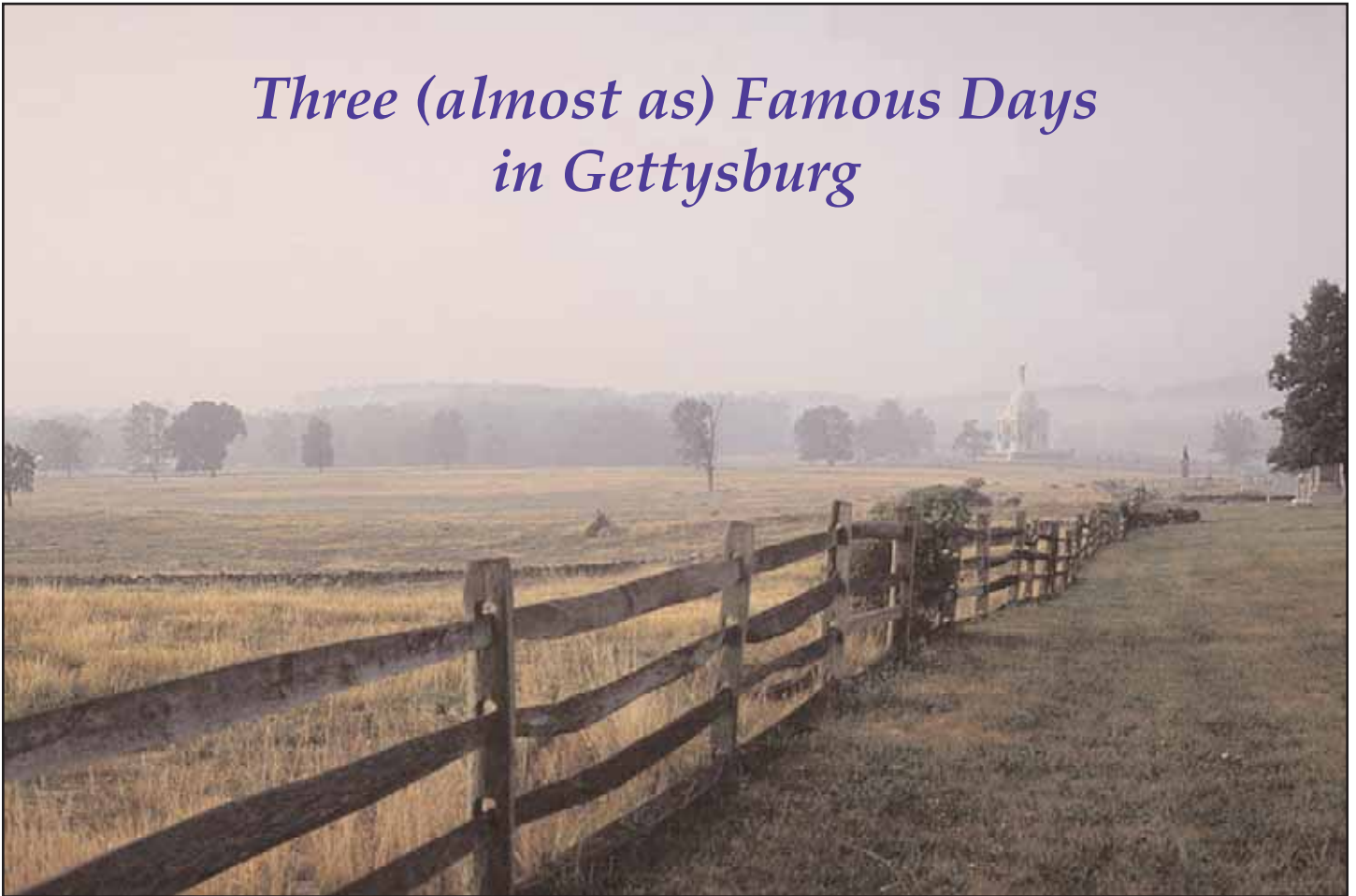

While perhaps not as well known as the defining battle of the Civil War that occurred in Gettysburg nearly a century and a half ago, we hope the 2008 PROP conference will be nearly as memorable to recycling and composting professionals in Pennsylvania. We will again feature:

PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATION

This year's conference features **four** sessions that will allow attendees to earn Professional Certification Credits. Thursday offers four classes, each worth .3 CEUs. They include Organics Collection, Compost Marketing, Grant Writing and Buying & Using Recycled.

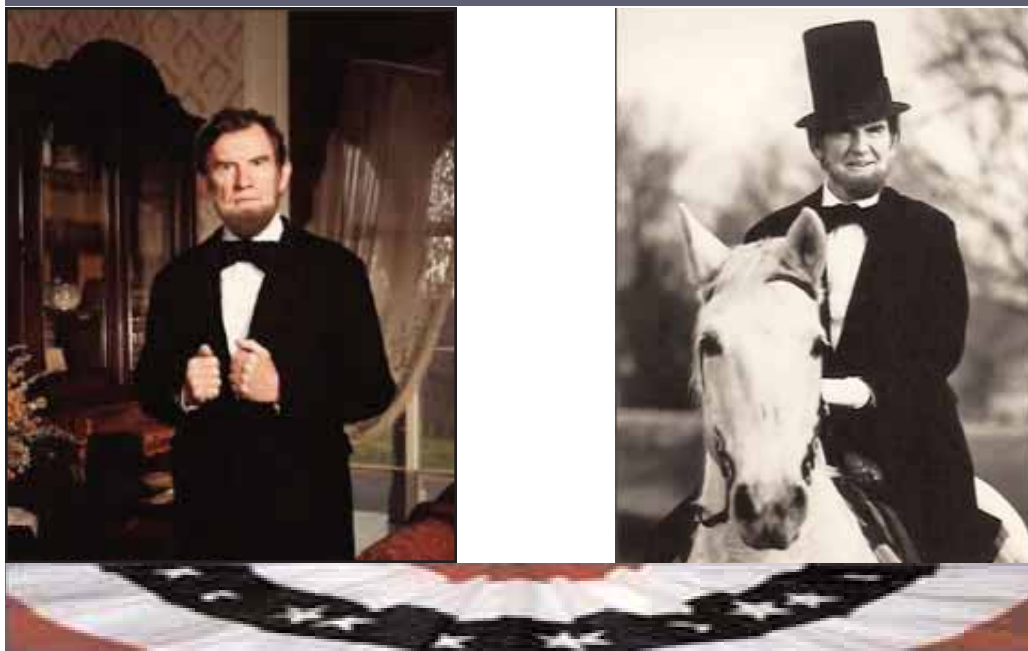
