PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATION

This year's conference features **four** sessions that will allow attendees to earn Professional Certification Credits. Thursday offers four classes, each worth .3 CEUs. They include Organics Collection, Compost Marketing, Grant Writing and Buying & Using Recycled.



COUNTY, MUNICIPAL OR AUTHORITY PACKAGES

INDOOR AND OUTDOOR EXHIBIT AREAS

This conference will also feature outdoor exhibit space directly outside the exhibit hall. (See the diagram on page 10.) Exhibitors at PROP's annual conference have access to one of the largest annual gatherings of recycling and composting professionals in the United States. This year we return to the popular format with meals being held in the center of the exhibit hall. Our exhibition time kicks off Wednesday, July 30th with a reception in the Exhibit Hall. That evening, weather permitting, we will be enjoying our traditional PROP Picnic on the Terrace. 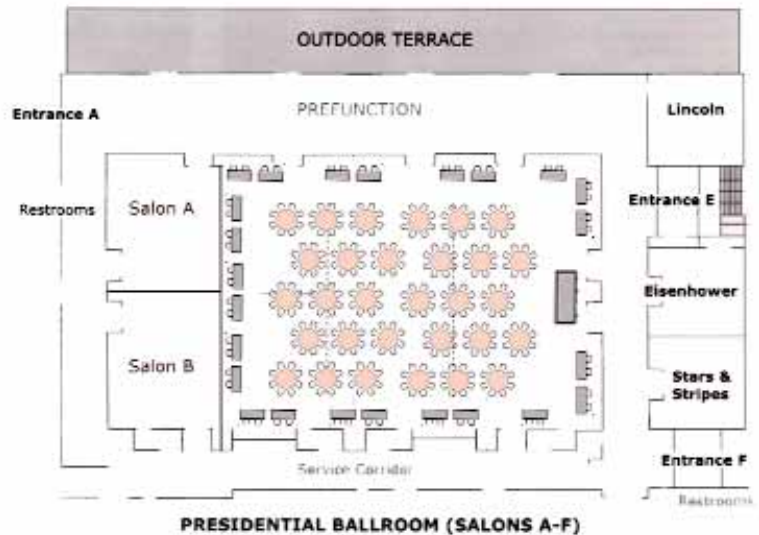
Conference Exhibit Hall
